

Please consider yourself invited to participate in Operation Lookout®. Find below information about the program and how you can start running Operation Lookout in your community.

Operation Lookout® was initially developed and trademarked by Against Drunk Driving (ADD) in 1992; it is a national program that engages road users to report suspected impaired drivers by dialing 9-1-1 or *OPP. OCCID has been asked to take responsibility for administering the program, and have pulled together some materials and resources for any interested parties.

The program makes streets safer in two ways: by showing all drivers that people are watching and thus, impaired drivers are more likely to be caught; and secondly, the program intervenes to remove unsafe drivers from the road before they cause harm to themselves or others. In communities where the program is hosted, Operation Lookout® has shown a four-fold increase in the numbers of impaired drivers reported to police and also serves as a significant deterrent to offenders. Operation Lookout® addresses all forms of impaired driving (e.g. drugs, fatigue) and can even help a driver who may be suffering a medical emergency.



The following communities are currently running or have recently run Operation Lookout in Ontario:

Bancroft, Belleville, Brockville, Bruce Peninsula, Chatham, Cornwall, Elgin County, Gananoque, Frontenac, Grenville, Grey County, Haldimand, Hastings, Hawkesbury, Huron, Ingersoll, Kingston, Leeds, Lennox and Addington, Little Current/Manitoulin, London, Markstay, Napanee, Norfolk, Oshawa, Ottawa, Owen Sound, Peterborough, Port Hope, Prescott, St. Catharines, St. Thomas, Sharbot Lake, South Bruce, Sudbury, Tillsonburg, and Woodstock.

There is a licence agreement, but no fee associated with Operation Lookout. Communities provide annual updates on their local program's activities. OCCID is producing signs (example at left) and other resources that would be given to community groups for free, up to 20, and more if desired on a cost-recovery basis.
